



## Double Pinwheel Block

Each 9" (finished) Block:

1 of 3 ½" sq fabric A

4 of 3 ½" HST fabric B/bkgrd

4 of 3 ½" HST fabric C/bkgrd

4 HSTs at a time: Place one 5 ½" square (sq) Fabric B and one 5 ½" sq bkgrd fabric together, right sides together. Sew ¼" from edge around all 4 sides. Mark diagonal cutting lines in both directions. Cut on the diagonals, press carefully (this method leaves bias edges) and trim each resulting HST to 3 ½" . Repeat to make 4 HSTs with fabric C.

Assemble HSTs and center 3 ½" square (fabric A) in rows. Press seams in alternating rows in opposite directions. Sew rows together, nesting seams.

### Fabric for 16 blocks:

Fabric A : 16 of 3 ½" sq (less than ¼ yd or FQ, < 2 strips of 3 ½" by WOF)

Fabric B: 16 of 5 ½" sq = (less than ½ yd, < 3 strips of 5 ½" by WOF)

Fabric C: 16 of 5 ½" sq = (less than ½ yd, < 3 strips of 5 ½" by WOF)

Bkgrd Fabric: 32 of 5 ½" sq (less than 1 yd, < 5 strips of 5 ½" by WOF)

Of course, this block can be made in different sizes, just adjust the size of the HSTs and center sq.
